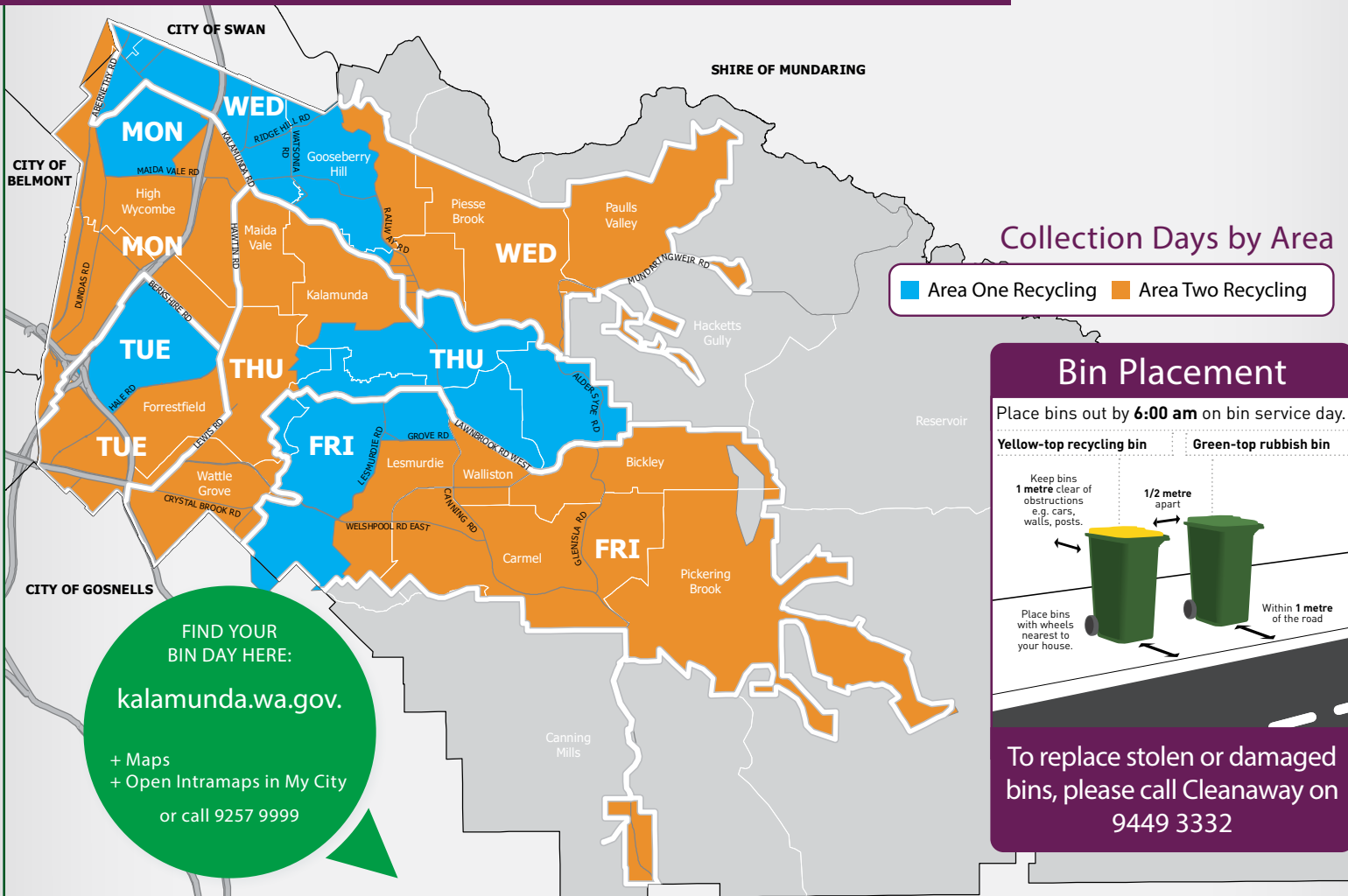

#### Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

There are many household wastes and recyclable items that CANNOT be placed in either your General Waste Bin or your Recycling Bin.

Household Hazardous Waste items including aerosol cans and batteries cause fires in collection vehicles and materials sorting facilities, and must NOT be placed in any type of bins. For more details see page 4.

## 4 Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Disposal

There are a number of HHW items which must NOT be placed in your bins. These HHW items can be taken to any permanent HHW facility such as Red Hill Waste Management Facility. It is free of charge to take 20kg/20L per material type. Please refer to the table below for some of the HHW item(s) that can be disposed of at each facility.

Soft plastics are commonly used for food packaging and can be scrunched up easily in your hand. This type of plastic CANNOT go in your yellow top recycling bin. Instead it can be taken to REDcycle drop off points located at most major supermarkets. For more details [redcycle.net.au](http://redcycle.net.au)



The skip bin service is an on-demand service. Residents can select from either a general waste bin (blue) or green waste bin (green). Households are entitled to any combination of three skip bins per financial year (excludes commercial & industrial premises). Both the general & green waste skip bins are 3 cubic metres.

Households that meet the following criteria are entitled to additional green waste bin(s) only, to assist with bush fire management.

- » One additional green waste bin is available for properties 2000m<sup>2</sup> – 5000m<sup>2</sup>
- » Two additional green waste bins are available for properties over 5000m<sup>2</sup>

### Please remember

- » Skip bins are placed to the left of the driveway
- » Bins must remain where they are placed
- » Keep the area clear so the Cleanaway driver can easily remove the bin
- » Bins may be delivered full, but will be emptied by 6pm at the latest the same day
- » If a bin needs to be emptied by the City of Kalamunda due to misuse, the resident will be responsible for all costs incurred
- » Day of use is the day following delivery, book gardeners or help accordingly
- » Allocations have to be used by 30 June each year - i.e. Delivered on-site by 30th June

Greenwaste collected from the Green Waste skip bins is mulched & re-used, reducing the amount of waste sent to landfill. Please keep green waste free of contamination.

### Ordering a Skip Bin

The City has developed an online booking system allowing residents to register details, book days in advance and view allocations.

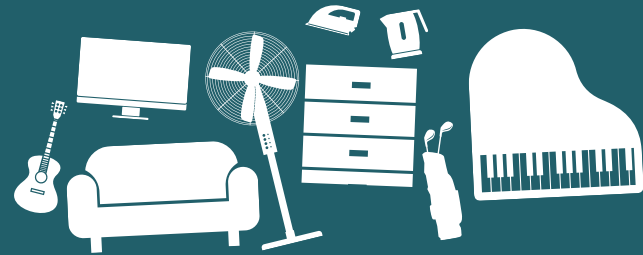
