IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- » The registration period runs from 1 November to 31 October each year. The expiry date of this registration is shown on your cat's registration certificate, and on your cat's registration tag.
- » First time one year registrations received on or after 1 June each year are subject to a 50% concession on the ordinary fees.
- » It is important to notify the City of Kalamunda of any change of address or ownership of the cat within 7 days.
- » All cats aged six months and over must be sterilised (unless approved by local government as a Cat Breeder, conditions apply), microchipped and registered. Proof of sterilisation is required and the microchip number must be provided with the application, it will then be added to the City database.
- » Cats must wear a current registration tag attached to their collar. This will help Rangers reunite you with your cat should it become lost.
- » The maximum number of cats is two (2) per property in the City of Kalamunda.
- » Council approval is required to keep more than the prescribed number (2) per property.
