3.0 PRESENTATION OF THE 2015 ANNUAL REPORT

3.1 <u>Rupert Duckworth, Kalamunda</u>

Q. There are currently three developments in Kalamunda which I believe are out of keeping with Kalamunda's heritage, current town planning and urban guidelines and create an undesirable image. Please can the Shire provide details of how it will develop new processes and review and strengthen existing processes to ensure all parties have the necessary legislative and regulatory controls and guidance to make significant progress against, and achieve the objectives of Goal Four -Kalamunda Developments Outcomes 4.2 to 4.5 and Goal Six, Kalamunda Leads, Outcomes 6.1 to 6.5 as presented in the Annual Report?

The groups I represent believe by doing this the Shire will develop and deliver an appropriate, vibrant community centre using community engagement and avoid unnecessary referrals to the State Administrative Tribunal.

A. The Presiding Member commented that in 2016 the Shire intends to review its strategic plans and a series of motions have been passed by this Council that are setting the Shire up for a process of strategic planning - including the engagement of consultants to assist with a series of community forums throughout the Shire to enable a two-way communication. He added planning policies would develop out of these forums and be offered for public comment. This will be a massive community consultation process to begin a dialogue with the community on this issue.

3.2 <u>Peter Forrest - Kalamunda</u>

- Q1. I also feel there is a weakness with regard to community consultation and the lack of interchange of ideas is a concern; I draw your attention to the Strategic Assessment of the Perth and Peel Region soon to be released; will the Shire Councillors read this document?
- A1. Presiding Member indicated that when this document is released copies will be circulated to Shire Councillors, he reiterated that there will be increased community consultation and believed the Shire would closely examine this document when released and possibly make comment.
- Q2. I previously produced an independent functional review of the whole planning system immediately after the last election and sent to all local governments in the state; have all Councillors in the Shire seen this?
- A2. The Presiding Member requested that Peter Forrest forward the document to him direct and he will forward to all Councillors.
