Erect, loose shrub, 0.6-3 m high. Fl. yellow, Aug to Nov. Often in lateritic or granitic gravelly soils.

Prickly Moses - A shrub to 1.5 m tall, branching freely; branchlets spine tipped, slightly flexuose, pale green, glabrous or with sparse, to 3 mm long, erect hairs. Plant information available

Candle | Slender Banksia: Lignotuberous tree-shrub, 0.4-10 m high. epicormic buds. Fl. yellow, Oct-Dec or Jan-Feb. Sand dunes, sandplains.

Honeypot Dryandra: Shrub, 0.15-1.5 m high. Fl. cream-yellow-orange-pink/red-brown, Apr or Jul to Nov. Sandy soils, gravel, laterite, granite.
