The IIBT Certificate IV in Business prepares you to graduate with the skills needed to begin a career in business, apply for direct university entrance combined with English ATAR and WACE (discuss with your school Career Counsellor) or continue studying at IIBT by progressing into our Diploma of Business Administration. Once you have successfully completed our Diploma, you have the choice to continue your studies with direct entry into 2nd year at university.

This course provides students with the skills to obtain employment across various industry sectors. Possible job titles relevant to this qualification include: Accounts Assistant, Personal Assistant, Office Administrator and Project Assistant.

DIPLOMA OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

HIGHER EDUCATION

Entry into 2nd year and 3rd year of undergraduate study in IIBT Partner Universities/ Institutes

The Diploma of Business Administration is equivalent to the first year of a business-related undergraduate degree at Australian universities/Higher Education Institutions. On successful completion of the course, students are eligible to enter second year of a relevant Bachelor degree at one of IIBT's partner universities/higher education institutions including ECU, Curtin, Murdoch, Wollongong, CQU and Sheridan.

The Diploma of Business Administration covers the first year equivalent of a commerce/business degree, allowing students to learn key areas of knowledge of the business field. This provides students with skills necessary to choose a relevant bachelor degree that fits their future career prospects, eliminating course changes once at university.

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

WORKPLACE **LEARNING**

Students studying at IIBT may be required to attend a workplace to gain meaningful and practical work skills.

Workplace learning provides students with an opportunity to experience a real working environment which enhances their understanding of their studies.

IIBT works together with students, their school and industry to place students in an environment where they can develop and improve their skills in preparation for transition from school to work. Workplace learning helps students decide if a particular industry or job is right for them.

Students chosen for a workplace opportunity will be given a Workplace Learning Logbook to complete during their work placement. They will have a list of tasks that relate directly to their vocational studies which they will need to complete. Most work placements are between 5-10 days, however, may be longer depending on student experience.

During and after work placement, the student is required to respond to questions based on the Core Skills for Work Developmental Framework. These are part of the Workplace Learning Logbook.
